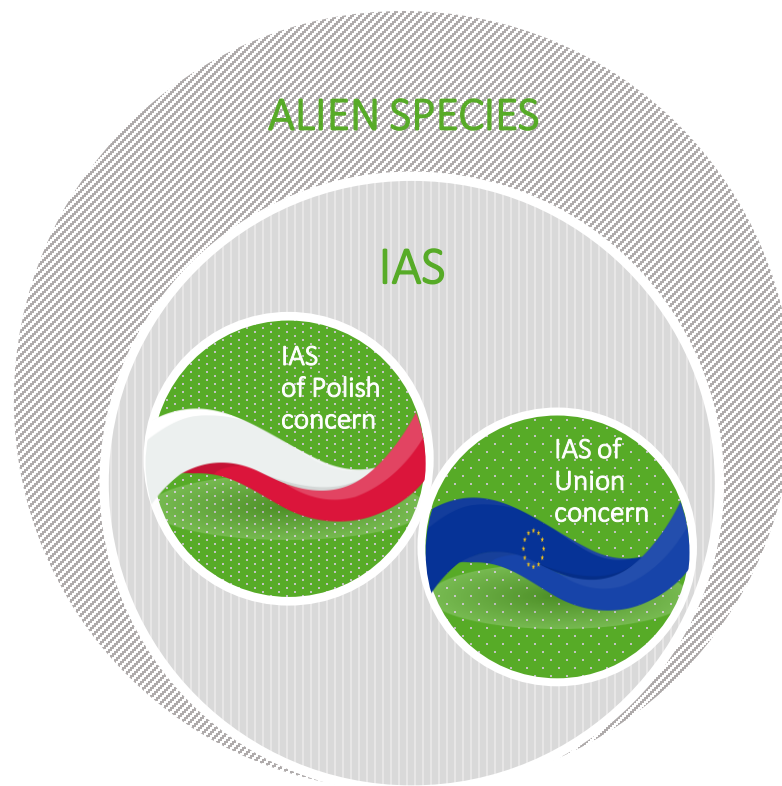

ACT ON ALIEN SPECIES of 11 August 2021
(Journal of Laws, item 2023, item 1589, as
amended)



- contains provisions detailing the EU regulation
- similar provisions for IAS from the Polish list as for IAS from the EU list

REGULATION of the Council of Ministers of 9 December 2022 on **THE LIST OF IAS OF THE UNION CONCERN AND THE LIST OF IAS OF POLISH CONCERN, MANAGEMENT MEASURES AND MEASURES AIMED AT RESTORING THE NATURAL STATE OF ECOSYSTEMS** (Journal of Laws item 2649)

- Polish IAS list (15)
- division of PL and EU IAS into: those subject to rapid elimination / those widely spread
- possible management measures (physical and chemical measures) and restoration measures

ACT ON ALIEN SPECIES of 11 August 2021

- prohibition on introduction and moving in the environment of every alien species - with some exceptions (eg. plants in agriculture or in urban areas, hunting)
- prohibitions against PL IAS similar to those for EU IAS
- permits: issuing authorities, content of application, etc.
- additional permits for: pets and purchase of commercial stock (in transition period), management measures (keeping and usage), commercial use of IAS as part of management measures
- general obligation on reporting of: IAS occurrences in the environment and of management measures – to the local municipality
- Central Register for IAS Data (surveillance system): storage of IAS occurrences & management measures and permits; basic data are visible in Geoserwis
 - data is entered by the regional directorate for environmental protection/national park/marine office/Chief Marine Inspectorate
 - eg. in 2025: 5820 IAS occurrences were entered, including approximately 55 occurrences of IAS subject to rapid elimination

ACT ON ALIEN SPECIES of 11 August 2021

- obligation for different actors to undertake management measures: to eliminate, control, or isolate IAS
 - mainly the manager of the property is responsible for the measures, but may ask the municipality to take over the responsibility; in the event of no action, the municipality may remove the IAS at the expense of the landowner
 - except of the rapid eradication - which is the responsibility of the: regional director for environmental protection/director of national park/director of marine office/Chief Marine Inspector
 - IAS are also hunted under the hunting law: in 2029-2024 ca. 95 000 raccoon dogs and 20 000 racoons were shot
- animal asylums (IAS, protected species, dangerous species, CITES)
 - currently ca. 20 asylums, a Central Animal Asylum is planned
- the "polluter pays" principle in the event of IAS release into the environment
- official controls of IAS imports by customs authorities
- administrative fines imposed by the Regional Director for Environmental Protection (up to PLN 1 million – more than 200 000 EUR!) and criminal provisions
